Airport News

A massive expansion project has started at the airport. A new terminal and runway are under construction and scheduled for completion in 2010. This is expected to increase capacity to 37 million passengers a year. More terminals and runways are planned thereafter, however, and the airport authorities are expecting a capacity of 100 million passengers a year by 2026.

Owing to the traffic congestion due to the expansion project, travellers are requested to report to the airline check in counter well in advance in order to avoid off loading.

For International travel in Business class, reporting should be at least 02 hours prior to the departure time.

For International travel in Economy class, reporting should be at least 04 hours prior to the departure time.

For Domestic travel in Business/ Economy class, reporting should be at least 02 hours prior to the departure time.
