Due to the impacts of oversea tariffs and the overall declines of the ferrous metal sector, enterprises are all experiencing widespread losses. The nationwide campaign against involution was launched in July which supported the increase in the price of ferroalloys and the profits of enterprises has recovered slightly. However, whether alloys can sustain their upward momentum in the fourth quarter, how to address new capacity and high inventory levels, and whether overseas alloy demand will improve remain key concerns for the market.

Looking ahead, the metal industry is expected to witness three major trends: firstly, resource companies are likely to continue expanding internationally; secondly, the overseas expansion of leading mining companies is expected to drive the entire industrial chain abroad; and thirdly, green products in the industrial chain will be particularly favored. Consequently, it is anticipated that the traditional alloy industry is about to undergo a period of rapid transformation and growth
