### City Tour & Table Mountain

The perfect orientation tour of the beautiful city of Cape Town. Take in the sights and sounds of this cosmopolitan city with its diverse mix of cultures and absorb some the history that has shaped South Africa over the years. We start with a ride in the modern cable-car to the top of iconic Table Mountain and marvel at the spectacular views of the city and the entire Cape peninsula (weather permitting).

Then explore some of the many museums, historical buildings and famous landmarks in the city. Drive to District Six, the Castle of Good Hope and pause to take photographs of the colourful houses in the Bo-Kaap. Often the best way to experience a city is on foot – the Company Gardens (bordered by the Houses of Parliament and St Georges Cathedral), Long Street and Greenmarket Square provide such an opportunity.

### **Constantia OR Stellenbosch Wine Region.**

The wine producing regions of the Western Cape are arguably the most scenically beautiful in the world. Set against a backdrop of imposing, sandstone mountains, some two hundred estates and wineries producing award winning wines of international quality. Taste wines from one of the many modern "new-world" wineries or visit an estate with "old-world" heritage dating back over three hundred years.

## **Cape Malay Cooking Safari**

The Cape Malay Cooking Safari is a truly special Cape experience.

Your guide will lead you on a leisurely stroll through some of the more historic streets, giving you a chance to appreciate the extraordinary collection of pre-1840 architecture that resulted in this area being declared a national monument.

Then it's time to follow our noses towards the scents of ginger, coriander, cardamom, cinnamon, and chilli which drift tantalisingly from the storefronts and cafés, as we learn about the ingredients to make a typical Cape Malay dish.

It's "hands-on" during the informal cooking workshop which follows in a Bo-Kaap family home. We learn how to mix Masala, fold Samosas, and how to balance the delicate flavours of a Cape Malay curry.

Over a glass of *faloodah* (a traditional, lightly rose-scented milk drink) our hostess and cooking instructor will tell you more about the ways in which food, history and religion are interwoven in the Bo-Kaap culture.

Then it's time to sit back, relax, and appreciate your handwork and enjoy a traditional Malay Meal.

## **Cape Peninsula Tour**

Standing at the Cape of Good Hope, the most south-western point of Africa, is a very special experience.
